The East Islip Historical Society ("Society") asks you to support our **14th ANNUAL FATHER'S DAY BREAKFAST**.

The Society, founded in 1992, is a 501(c)3 organization and is dedicated to the preservation of history, traditions and artifacts of East Islip and its environs. As you may be aware, the Society publishes a monthly *Newsletter* and has members all over the country. Our monthly meetings are held the first Wednesday of every month, beginning at 7:30pm, at the Gatehouse, Brookwood Hall. These monthly meetings feature knowledgeable speakers on various topics of local and other historical interests. Meetings are not held July and August.

This past year has been a busy one for the East Islip Historical Society. You may have seen our exhibits and events written up in the *Islip Bulletin*. Some of the exhibits and displays in the East Islip Public Library's Local History Room have been changed. We have an entire cabinet dedicated to the former Rumluk Chevrolet. In our attempt to gather information from the community about the workers of the estates of our area, another cabinet features an "Upstairs/Downstairs" themed display -- a by-gone era of our own Downton Abbey. In addition, we participated in the Bayard Cutting Arboretum's Fall Festival and the Islip Arts Council's Antiques & Collectibles Show at Brookwood Hall. From December through the end of February the Society exhibited "*Our Story*" in the Town of Islip's Local History Exhibition Room at Brookwood Hall. This exhibit featured stories from our members and community history of the 20th Century. The Society's Third Annual Orphan Tree Lighting at Brookwood Hall was held December 7, 2012. Passing on the history of Brookwood Hall's orphan years, the Society held two Tea & Tours at Brookwood Hall in January and February. Since September, the Society has helped local high school students earn over 40 hours toward their community service requirements by assisting us at events mentioned above.
